Website Enhancements

Over the last few months, we've been making improvements to the website to help make a better experience for our users and guests. Last month, we added enhancements to import Excel files and append to your inventory. This month, we've done a number of different things that are very noticeable.

One great improvement has been the capability to update your current inventory via your upload. In order to update your current inventory, make sure you check the "Update Inventory Quantities Only" checkbox above the Upload button before pressing the Upload button.

Inventory File:

Add to current Inventory: Update Inventory Quantities Only:

(Check above if you want to keep your current inventory and add the items in this upload file to it) (Check above if you want to update the quantities in your current inventory from the values in this upload file)

NOTE: Uploads may take a few minutes, please allow the system time to finalize your import.

This option will update the quantities for items currently in your inventory. It will also add items that are not currently listed. This is handy when you have an inventory that you keep close watch on and update the quantities on your end. Then, when you want to update the quantities you have listed at ListInventory.com, you upload your file with the update checkbox checked and your listed inventory will match the inventory you

keep locally. It also allows you to upload only the changes you want to make to your inventory, which makes for a much smaller upload and quicker response.

DBF support

We received an import file from a customer in DBF format. Even though the DBF format is an older format, many programs use it for their data storage as well as export their data in that format. Just like Excel imports, if you desire to import DBF files, you need to either set your column configuration using the configuration tool or send a copy to us at help@listinventory.com for us to set the column configuration for the file to be imported correctly. If you need help using the configuration tool, please don't hesitate to contact us.


If you have made a video review of ListInventory and would like to upload it, use the Browse button below to find your video and then click the Upload button.
